Summary of Legislation: The bill provides that when an individual files a notice of withdrawal listing an address different from the address on the individual's voter registration record, the individual's signature on the notice of withdrawal constitutes a request to the county voter registration office that the address on the individual's voter registration record be the same as the address on the notice of withdrawal.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The Election Division may have a very minor increase in workload to forward any state legislative or statewide office notice of withdrawal to the appropriate county voter registration office (CVRO), if not currently forwarded.

Explanation of State Revenues:

Explanation of Local Expenditures: CVRO's may see a small workload increase to verify/update addresses on future voter registrations of state and local candidates that withdraw from an election.
