SUBJECT: Sales Tax Exemption for Menstrual Discharge Collection Devices.

Summary of Legislation: The bill provides a sales tax exemption for menstrual discharge collection devices.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** The Department of State Revenue (DOR) will incur expenses to put the bill's changes in place. The DOR should be able to make these changes within current resource levels.

**Explanation of State Revenues:** The bill could reduce state revenues by an estimated \$5.8 M in FY 2027 and \$6.4 M in FY 2028. [In FY 2025, the state received \$10.6 B in total sales tax revenue.]

Sales tax is distributed as follows:

- 99.838% to the General Fund
- 0.131% to the Commuter Rail Service Fund
- 0.031% to the Industrial Rail Service Fund

Data from other states with similar exemptions is the basis for the estimated impact. The estimate was adjusted for tax rate, regional price parity, population, and inflation.
