Summary of Legislation: The bill prohibits a certificate holder or vendor from accepting a proposition bet from a collegiate athlete in the sport the collegiate athlete plays. It provides that the Indiana Gaming Commission (IGC) may impose a civil penalty upon an individual who: (1) is a collegiate athlete; and (2) attempted to place or placed a proposition bet on a game in the sport that the individual plays.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: *Indiana Gaming Commission:* The provisions in the bill are part of the agency's regular duties. It will not result in additional administrative cost.

Explanation of State Revenues: The bill allows the IGC to impose a civil penalty of up to \$10,000 on a collegiate athlete for attempting to place or placing a proposition bet on a game in the sport that the individual plays. This provision could increase penalty revenues deposited in the state General Fund. The fiscal impact starting in FY 2027 will depend on the number of violations of the provisions in the bill.
