## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-34-3-28.5.

**Synopsis:** Educational information on type 1 diabetes. Requires the department of education (department) to develop informational materials concerning type 1 diabetes for the parents of students and to publish the materials on the department's website. Requires public schools, including charter schools, to provide the informational materials concerning type 1 diabetes to a student's parent each year upon the student's enrollment.

Effective: July 1, 2026.

- (b) The department shall make the informational materials developed under subsection (a) available to public schools, including charter schools, by publishing the informational materials on the department's website.
- (c) Beginning with the 2026-2027 school year, the governing body of a school corporation or the equivalent authority of a charter school shall make the informational materials described in subsection (a) available to a student's parent each year upon the student's enrollment.
