Summary of Legislation: This bill requires public schools, including charter schools, to present an informational video on water safety to students enrolled in kindergarten through grade 12. The bill also requires the Department of Education to approve an informational video on water safety for various grade levels.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The bill requires the Department of Education to approve videos on water safety for use in public schools. The bill's requirements are within the agency's routine administrative functions and should be able to be implemented with no additional appropriations.
