## **SENATE BILL No. 126**

### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 16-42-19-18; IC 35-52-16-88.7.

**Synopsis:** Possession of a syringe. Repeals the crime of possession of a syringe in the health code (possession of a syringe remains a crime as possession of paraphernalia in the criminal code).

Effective: July 1, 2026.

### SENATE BILL No. 126

A BILL FOR AN ACT to repeal a provision of the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 16-42-19-18 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY
2	1, 2026]. Sec. 18. (a) A person may not possess with intent to:
3	(1) violate this chapter; or
4	(2) commit an offense described in IC 35-48-4;
5	a hypodermic syringe or needle or an instrument adapted for the use of
6	a controlled substance or legend drug by injection in a human being.
7	(b) A person who violates subsection (a) commits a Level 6 felony.
8	SECTION 2. IC 35-52-16-88.7 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY
9	1, 2026]. Sec. 88.7. IC 16-42-19-18 defines a crime concerning
10	injection devices.
