MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 140 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, line 5, delete "7" and insert "4".
- 2 Page 1, delete lines 7 through 17.
- 3 Page 2, line 1, delete "Sec. 3." and insert "**Sec. 2.**".
- 4 Page 2, line 19, delete "Sec. 4." and insert "**Sec. 3.**".
- 5 Page 2, line 22, delete "platform, electronic mail, or" and insert
- 6 "**platform.**".
- 7 Page 2, delete line 23.
- 8 Page 2, line 24, delete "Sec. 5." and insert "**Sec. 4.**".
- 9 Page 2, delete lines 33 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
- 10 insert:
- 11 "**Sec. 5. (a) A person who:**
- 12 (1) with the intent to place an individual in fear of bodily
- 13 injury or damage to the individual's property; or
- 14 (2) with the intent to aid, induce, or cause another person to:
- 15 (A) cause bodily injury to the individual;
- 16 (B) damage the individual's property; or
- 17 (C) commit a crime against the individual;
- 18 posts personal information of the individual commits doxxing, a
- 19 Class A misdemeanor, except as provided in subsection (b).
- 20 (b) An offense under subsection (a) is a:
- 21 (1) Level 6 felony if the posting of the personal information
- 22 results in the individual suffering serious bodily injury; and

1 **(2) Level 5 felony if the posting of the personal information**
2 **results in the individual suffering a catastrophic injury or**
3 **death."**
