A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 27-1-24.6-6, AS ADDED BY P.L.216-2025,
2 SECTION 41, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 6. (a) A health plan must provide the amount of
4 the national average drug acquisition cost for a generic drug to the plan
5 sponsor.
6 (b) A pharmacist (as defined in IC 27-1-24.5-9) or pharmacy
7 (as defined in IC 27-1-24.5-11) must provide the amount of the
8 national average drug acquisition cost for a generic drug on the
9 written materials provided to an individual at the point of sale of
10 the generic drug.

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
