Summary of Legislation: This bill requires the Department of Agriculture (ISDA) to conduct a study to evaluate the feasibility of establishing community or urban microfarm zones statewide. The bill requires ISDA to submit a report to the General Assembly containing certain findings and recommendations not later than December 1, 2027.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: This bill will increase workload for the ISDA to conduct a study on community or urban microfarm zones and submit a report to the General Assembly as prescribed in the bill. The study and report should be able to be completed with existing resources.
