**IMPACT:** Local

**Summary of Legislation:** This bill provides that certain:

- (1) indemnity;
- (2) choice of law; and
- (3) automatic renewal;

provisions contained in contracts entered into, amended, or renewed after June 30, 2026, between the governing body of a school corporation or the equivalent authority for a charter school and a vendor are against public policy and are void and unenforceable.

The bill provides that certain youth organizations may submit a grievance to the Department of Education if a public school refuses to allow the organization to provide information to students under certain conditions. It also provides that, if a public school allows a postsecondary educational institution to provide certain information to students, the public school shall allow military personnel to provide certain information to students.
