## SB 204 # 12

### DIGEST

Degree programs. Repeals a provision regarding eliminating certain degree programs.

- 1           Page 10, delete line 42, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
2           "SECTION 8. IC 21-18-9-10.7 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY  
3           1, 2026]. Sec. 10.7. (a) For each state educational institution degree  
4           program, if the:  
5                (1) average number of students who graduate over the  
6                immediately preceding three (3) years is fewer than:  
7                    (A) ten (10) students for a particular associate degree program;  
8                    (B) fifteen (15) students for a particular bachelor's degree  
9                    program;  
10                  (C) seven (7) students for a particular master's degree  
11                  program;  
12                  (D) three (3) students for a particular education specialist  
13                  program; or  
14                  (E) three (3) students for a particular doctorate degree  
15                  program; and  
16                (2) state educational institution would like to continue a degree  
17                program described in subdivision (1);  
18           the state educational institution must request approval from the  
19           commission to continue the degree program.  
20           (b) If the commission does not grant approval under subsection (a);  
21           the state educational institution must eliminate:  
22                (1) the degree program; and  
23                (2) any costs associated with the degree program."  
24           Page 11, delete lines 1 through 35.
