**Summary of Legislation:** This bill adopts the compact for a safe and equal convention of the states. It specifies compact requirements.

The bill also provides that each state that adopts the compact intends to ensure that the following rules are followed at a convention under Article V of the Constitution of the United States:

- (1) All voting is conducted on the basis of one-state, one-vote.
- (2) The convention shall not consider any proposed amendment on any topic other than the topics or subjects specifically enumerated in the applications of 2/3 of the several states which formed the basis for the call of the convention.
