

# PROPOSED AMENDMENT

## SB 211 # 1

### DIGEST

Candidacy declaration filing. Allows a person who wishes to be a candidate for a pro tempore appointment to certain local offices or school board offices to file a declaration of candidacy with the chair of the caucus or the circuit court clerk.

1       Page 2, between lines 39 and 40, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
2       "SECTION 3. IC 3-13-11-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
3       FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 7. (a) This section does  
4       not apply to a vacancy filled by a county chairman under section 5(c)  
5       of this chapter.  
6       (b) A person who wishes to be a candidate for pro tempore  
7       appointment to fill a vacancy under this chapter must file:  
8           (1) a declaration of candidacy with:  
9              (A) the chairman of the caucus; **and or**  
10             (B) **the circuit court clerk; and**  
11           (2) a statement of economic interests with the commission on  
12           judicial qualifications if the vacancy is in the office of prosecuting  
13           attorney;  
14           at least seventy-two (72) hours before the time fixed for the caucus.".   
15       Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
