

# PROPOSED AMENDMENT

## SB 222 # 2

### DIGEST

Home health agencies. Allows certain home health agencies to continue to provide services to a Medicaid recipient and receive Medicaid reimbursement while the agency's Medicare enrollment application is pending if the agency submitted the application or initiated the enrollment process before April 1, 2026.

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- 1       Page 45, between lines 12 and 13, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
2       "SECTION 60. IC 12-15-13-10 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA  
3       CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
4       [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 10. (a) This section applies to**  
5       **a home health agency that is:**  
6               **(1) licensed under IC 16-27-1;**  
7               **(2) enrolled as a Medicaid provider; and**  
8               **(3) in good standing as a Medicaid provider, as determined by**  
9               **the office of the secretary.**  
10       **(b) Notwithstanding any other law, rule, or bulletin, a home**  
11       **health agency licensed under IC 16-27-1 may continue to provide**  
12       **services to a Medicaid recipient and receive Medicaid**  
13       **reimbursement for the services while the home health agency's**  
14       **application for Medicare enrollment is pending if the home health**  
15       **agency:**  
16               **(1) submitted a Medicare enrollment application to the**  
17               **federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services; or**  
18               **(2) initiated the enrollment process with a federal Centers for**  
19               **Medicare and Medicaid Services approved accrediting**  
20               **organization;**  
21       **before April 1, 2026."**  
22       Page 90, after line 40, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
23       "SECTION 121. **An emergency is declared for this act.**"  
24       Re-number all SECTIONS consecutively.
