

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SB 225 # 6

DIGEST

Nonprofit subsidiary corporation. Amends the duties of a nonprofit subsidiary corporation established by the Indiana department of health.

- 1 Page 3, between lines 18 and 19, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 5. IC 16-19-3-30, AS AMENDED BY P.L.181-2015,
3 SECTION 39, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 30. (a) The state department may establish a
5 nonprofit subsidiary corporation that is exempt from federal income
6 taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, to
7 solicit and accept private funding, gifts, donations, bequests, devises,
8 and contributions.
9 (b) A subsidiary corporation established under this section:
10 (1) shall use money received under subsection (a) to carry out in
11 any manner the purposes and programs of the state department,
12 which may include programs intended to reduce infant mortality,
13 increase childhood immunizations, reduce obesity, ~~and~~ reduce
14 smoking rates, **and enhance health care resources and**
15 **infrastructure for veterans;**
16 (2) shall report to the budget committee each year concerning:
17 (A) the use of money received under subsection (a); and
18 (B) the balances in any accounts or funds established by the
19 subsidiary corporation; and
20 (3) may deposit money received under subsection (a) in an
21 account or fund that is:
22 (A) administered by the subsidiary corporation; and
23 (B) not part of the state treasury.
24 (c) A subsidiary corporation established under this section is
25 governed by a board of directors comprised of members appointed by
26 the governor. Employees of the state department may serve on the
27 board of directors.

1 (d) Employees of the state department shall provide administrative
2 support for a subsidiary corporation established under this section.
3 Employees of the state department directly involved in the subsidiary
4 corporation established under this section may engage in fundraising
5 activities on behalf of the subsidiary corporation.

6 (e) The state board of accounts shall audit a subsidiary corporation
7 established under this section."

8 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
