Summary of Legislation: This bill makes the following changes to the law regarding the Midwest Continental Divide Commission (MCDC):

- (1) It amends the definition of a "land use and zoning plan" (plan) to provide that it is a plan and not an overlay district.
- (2) It also requires the commission to consider any change or variance in zoning to be consistent with the plan that is:
 - (A) inconsistent with the plan; and
 - (B) not more than 1/2 mile from a trail project approved by the commission and the eligible county or city.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.
