

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SB 275 # 1

DIGEST

Claims against a decedent's estate. Provides that a claim by the estate recovery unit of the office of Medicaid policy and planning (estate recovery unit) is forever barred unless the estate recovery unit files a claim in the court in which the decedent's estate is being administered not later than 180 days after the estate has been opened. (The time limitation for filing a claim would be repealed under the current bill.)

1 Page 4, delete lines 32 through 39, begin a new paragraph and
2 insert:
3 "(g) A claim by the unit against a decedent's estate is forever barred
4 unless
5 (1) the unit files a claim in the court in which the decedent's estate
6 is being administered ~~or~~
7 (2) the unit opens an estate for the decedent and files a claim
8 against the decedent in the estate;
9 not later than ~~one hundred twenty (120) days~~ **one hundred eighty**
10 **(180) days** after the ~~date of death of the decedent.~~ **estate has been**
11 **opened."**
 (Reference is to SB 275 as introduced.)
