

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SB 275 # 20

DIGEST

FSSA fiscal matters. Deletes provisions reducing the income levels as a percentage of the federal poverty level for purposes of the Medicaid eligibility of certain Medicare beneficiaries. Requires the office of the secretary of family and social services to collaborate with certain entities to develop a new reimbursement methodology for home health services. Requires a provider of services under a home and community based services waiver to provide certain information to an individual receiving services.

2 Delete page 2.
3 Page 3, delete lines 1 through 9, begin a new paragraph and insert:
4 "SECTION 2. IC 12-15-11-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
5 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
6 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: **Sec. 11. A provider of services under
7 a home and community based services waiver (as defined in
8 IC 12-8-1.6-2) shall do the following:**
9 (1) Upon request by an individual receiving services under the
10 waiver or the individual's legal guardian, but not more than
11 once per calendar quarter, provide to the individual or the
12 individual's legal guardian the provider's accounting records
13 of service delivery for the recipient.
14 (2) Upon request, but not more than twice per calendar year,
15 provide to an individual receiving services under the waiver
16 an itemized statement of the services billed by the provider
17 for the recipient. The statement must be in plain language."
18 Page 3, delete lines 23 through 30, begin a new paragraph and
19 insert:
20 "SECTION 4. IC 12-15-34-14.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.217-2017,
21 SECTION 79, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
22 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 14.5. (a) This section is effective beginning July
23 1, 2017.
24 (b) The office of the secretary may not reduce reimbursement for

1 home health services.

2 (c) 405 IAC 1-4.2-4(l) and any successor rule concerning reducing
3 home health services reimbursement are void and may not be renewed
4 or otherwise implemented.

5 **(d) This section expires June 30, 2027.**

6 SECTION 5. IC 12-15-34-14.6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
7 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
8 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 14.6. (a) The office of the**
9 **secretary shall, in partnership and collaboration with a home**
10 **health services association and providers of home health services,**
11 **develop a new reimbursement methodology for home health**
12 **services and, not later than November 30, 2026, submit the new**
13 **reimbursement methodology for home health services to the**
14 **legislative council in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6.**

15 **(b) This section expires December 31, 2027."**
