



SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 285 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, line 20, delete "offer to transport the person to a" and insert
- 2 **"provide the person with information regarding locations**
- 3 **authorized by law to provide services or shelter."**
- 4 Page 2, delete lines 21 through 22.
- 5 Page 2, line 30, delete "including a forensic" and insert **"including:**
- 6 **(1) a prosecutorial diversion program under IC 33-39-1-8; or**
- 7 **(2) a forensic diversion program under IC 11-12-3.7."**
- 8 Page 2, delete line 31, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 9 **"(e) If a law enforcement officer has reasonable grounds to**
- 10 **believe that a person is either dangerous or gravely disabled, and**
- 11 **is in immediate need of hospitalization and treatment, an officer**
- 12 **may initiate emergency detention procedures under IC 12-26-5."**
- 13 Page 3, line 14, after "number of" insert **"citations issued and"**.
- 14 Page 3, delete lines 17 through 19, begin a new paragraph and
- 15 insert:
- 16 **"Sec. 5. (a) Subject to subsection (b), this chapter does not**
- 17 **prohibit a policy, program, or order of a political subdivision that:**
- 18 **(1) encourages a diversion program; or**
- 19 **(2) encourages or requires providing housing or shelter**
- 20 **services in lieu of a citation or arrest.**
- 21 **(b) A policy, program, or order described in subsection (a) may**
- 22 **not allow a person to remain in the public area beyond the**
- 23 **forty-eight (48) hour period of time after receiving a warning**

- 1 **under section (1)(b) of this chapter."**
