MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Courts and Criminal Code, to which was referred Senate Bill 285, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 1, line 6, delete "Part".
- 2 Page 1, line 9, delete "Part".
- 3 Page 2, between lines 2 and 3, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 4 "SECTION 3. IC 12-26-1-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.205-2023,
- 5 SECTION 5, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 6 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 1. (a) **As used in this section, "gravely**
- 7 **disabled" means a condition in which an individual, as a result of**
- 8 **mental illness, is in danger of coming to harm because the**
- 9 **individual:**
- 10 **(1) is unable to provide for the individual's food, clothing,**
- 11 **shelter, or other essential human needs; or**
- 12 **(2) has a substantial impairment or an obvious deterioration**

1 of judgment, reasoning, or behavior that results in the
 2 individual being unable to function independently; or
 3 (3) lacks a fixed, regular, and adequate shelter, resulting in
 4 the individual remaining outdoors in places not designed for
 5 or ordinarily used for sleeping during weather conditions that
 6 are likely to result in death or serious physical injury, if:

7 (A) the individual has refused transportation to a shelter
 8 or mental health service provider; and

9 (B) a shelter or mental health service provider was
 10 reasonably offered and available.

11 (b) An individual who is mentally ill and either dangerous or
 12 gravely disabled may be involuntarily detained or committed under any
 13 of the following statutes:

14 (1) IC 12-26-5 (emergency detention).

15 (2) IC 12-26-6 (temporary commitment).

16 (3) IC 12-26-7 (regular commitment).".

17 Page 2, line 13, delete "camp, sleep," and insert "**camp on, sleep**
 18 **on,**".

19 Page 2, delete lines 16 through 39, begin a new paragraph, and
 20 insert:

21 "**(b) If a person violates subsection (a), the law enforcement**
 22 **officer who discovers the violation shall first determine if there are**
 23 **reasonable grounds for an emergency detention of the person. If**
 24 **there are reasonable grounds for an emergency detention, the law**
 25 **enforcement officer shall proceed under IC 12-26-5 and not this**
 26 **chapter.**

27 (c) **If:**

28 (1) **a person violates subsection (a);**

29 (2) **the person has not previously violated subsection (a); and**

30 (3) **subsection (b) does not apply;**

31 **the law enforcement officer who discovers the violation shall first**
 32 **give the person a warning and provide the person with information**
 33 **regarding locations authorized by law to provide services or**
 34 **shelter.**

35 (d) **A person who knowingly or intentionally violates subsection**
 36 **(a) commits street camping, a Class C misdemeanor, if:**

37 (1) **subsection (b) does not apply;**

38 (2) **the person has received a warning under subsection (c);**

- 1 **(3) at least forty-eight (48) hours have elapsed since the**
 - 2 **warning was issued; and**
 - 3 **(4) the person is camping or sleeping on, or using for long**
 - 4 **term shelter, land owned by the state or a political subdivision**
 - 5 **that is located within a three hundred (300) foot radius of the**
 - 6 **location where the warning under subsection (c) was issued.**
 - 7 **(e) A person charged with an offense under subsection (d) is**
 - 8 **eligible to participate in a diversion program, including:**
 - 9 **(1) a prosecutorial diversion program under IC 33-39-1-8; or**
 - 10 **(2) a forensic diversion program under IC 11-12-3.7".**
 - 11 Page 3, delete lines 11 through 19.
 - 12 Page 3, line 32, delete "(1)(c)(3)" and insert "**1(c)(3)**".
 - 13 Page 3, line 33, delete "(1)(b)" and insert "**1(b)**".
 - 14 Re-number all SECTIONS consecutively.
