Your Committee on Courts and Criminal Code, to which was referred Senate Bill 291, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

- 1 Replace the effective dates in SECTIONS 1 through 11 with
- 2 "[EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]".
- 3 Page 3, delete lines 13 through 25.
- 4 Page 4, line 30, after "property;" insert "**and**
- 5 **(4) access the following information for official court security**
- 6 **purposes only:**
- 7 (A) Criminal history record information, including limited
- 8 and full records, obtained through state or federal criminal
- 9 justice information systems.
- 10 (B) Records of the bureau of motor vehicles, including
- 11 driver's license information, vehicle registration data, and
- 12 associated identifying information.
- 13 (C) Sensitive law enforcement intelligence information,
- 14 including threat assessments, alerts, bulletins, and
- 15 intelligence products, when the information:

- 1 (i) relates to the safety and security of a supreme court
 2 justice, court staff, court facilities, or court proceedings;
 3 and
 4 (ii) is provided by, or accessed through, a law
 5 enforcement agency or criminal justice information
 6 system authorized to disseminate the information."

7 Page 4, delete lines 31 through 42.

8 Page 5, delete lines 1 through 5.

9 Page 7, line 6, after "property;" insert "and

10 (4) access the following information for official court security
 11 purposes only:

12 (A) Criminal history record information, including limited
 13 and full records, obtained through state or federal criminal
 14 justice information systems.

15 (B) Records of the bureau of motor vehicles, including
 16 driver's license information, vehicle registration data, and
 17 associated identifying information.

18 (C) Sensitive law enforcement intelligence information,
 19 including threat assessments, alerts, bulletins, and
 20 intelligence products, when the information:

21 (i) relates to the safety and security of a court of appeals
 22 and the tax court judge, court staff, court facilities, or
 23 court proceedings; and

24 (ii) is provided by, or accessed through, a law
 25 enforcement agency or criminal justice information
 26 system authorized to disseminate the information."

27 Page 7, delete lines 7 through 23.

28 Page 8, delete lines 9 through 12, begin a new paragraph and insert:

29 "SECTION 9. An emergency is declared for this act."

30 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
