- 3 Page 1, delete lines 1 through 17.
- 4 Page 2, delete lines 1 through 4.
- 5 Page 3, line 4, after "board;" insert "**and**".
- 6 Page 3, line 7, delete "Pharmacy; and" and insert "**Pharmacy.**".
- 7 Page 3, delete lines 8 through 15.
- 8 Page 3, delete lines 31 through 32.
- 9 Page 4, line 2, after "Pharmacy;" insert "**and**".
- 10 Page 4, line 7, delete "board;" and insert "board."
- 11 Page 4, line 7, strike "and".
- 12 Page 4, line 8, strike "(3) the individual has successfully

- 1 completed".
- 2 Page 4, line 11, delete "the initial course of education described".
- 3 Page 4, delete line 12.
- 4 Page 4, line 19, after "Pharmacy;" insert "**and**".
- 5 Page 4, line 27, after "Pharmacy" delete ";" and insert ".".
- 6 Page 4, line 27, strike "and".
- 7 Page 4, line 28, strike "(3) the individual has successfully
- 8 completed".
- 9 Page 4, line 31, delete "the initial course of education described".
- 10 Page 4, delete line 32.
- 11 Page 5, after line 39, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 12 "SECTION 8. **An emergency is declared for this act.**".
- 13 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
