**Summary of Legislation:** (Amended) *Standards and Requirements*- The bill removes an examination requirement for certain pharmacists for license reciprocity. It requires an individual to pass the North American Pharmacist Licensure Examination to be eligible for licensure as a pharmacist.

*Indiana Administrative Code*- The bill voids or requires the amendment of certain administrative rules. It also makes technical changes.

**Effective Date:** (Amended) Upon passage.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** (Revised) *Standards and Requirements*- The Professional Licensing Agency (PLA) would likely update their website and notify affected practitioners of the bill's changes. These are routine administrative functions and should be able to be implemented within the PLA's existing staff and resources.
