1       A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION recognizing the  
2       Donated Dental Services program.

3       *Whereas, Recognizing a need for many Hoosiers, the  
4       Indiana Dental Association and Dental Lifeline Network  
5       teamed up to create Indiana's Donated Dental Services (DDS)  
6       program;*

7       *Whereas, The DDS's goal is to help provide dental  
8       treatment to Hoosiers who have disabilities, medical fragilities,  
9       or are elderly;*

10       *Whereas, The DDS network includes hundreds of  
11       volunteers, including 444 dentists and 98 dental labs;*

12       *Whereas, Since its inception in 1991, the DDS program has  
13       provided comprehensive dental treatment to 6,141 Hoosiers  
14       with seriously neglected dental problems; and*

15       *Whereas, This year, the DDS program donated \$21.8  
16       million in dental treatment to Hoosiers with disabilities or who  
17       are elderly or medically fragile: Therefore,*

18       *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly  
19       of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives  
20       concurring:*

21       SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly  
22       recognizes the tremendous impact the Donated Dental Services  
23       program has in Indiana.
