5 *Whereas, The National FFA Organization, established in*
6 *1928, and the Indiana FFA Association, established in 1929,*
7 *were created to prepare future generations for the challenges*
8 *of feeding a growing population;*

9 *Whereas, The National FFA Organization, which*
10 *encompasses all 50 states, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin*
11 *Islands, represents more than one million members in 9,407*
12 *chapters, while the Indiana FFA membership has grown to over*
13 *14,000 members and 230 chapters;*

14 *Whereas, Both organizations have become dynamic youth*
15 *organizations with a mission to change lives and prepare*
16 *members for premier leadership, personal growth, and career*
17 *success through agricultural education;*

18 *Whereas, FFA accomplishes this mission by developing*
19 *agricultural leaders, increasing awareness of the importance*
20 *of agriculture, strengthening the confidence of students*
21 *involved, promoting the choice of agriculture as a career,*
22 *encouraging agricultural experience programs, highlighting*
23 *wise management of community resources, developing*
24 *members' interpersonal skills and character, promoting*
25 *cooperation and healthy lifestyles, and encouraging excellence*
