SENATE RESOLUTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION memorializing Alice Wong.

2 *Whereas, Alice Wong, an artist, editor, and disability justice*
3 *activist, passed away on November 14, 2025, at the age of 51;*

4 *Whereas, Alice was a graduate of Carmel High School,*
5 *received her bachelor's degree from Indiana University-Purdue*
6 *University Indianapolis in 1997, and earned a master's degree*
7 *from the University of California, San Francisco in 2004;*

8 *Whereas, Alice was deeply dedicated to ensuring the*
9 *political and cultural visibility of individuals with disabilities,*
10 *cultivating a vibrant and diverse community rooted in joy,*
11 *abundance, mutual aid, and care;*

12 *Whereas, Alice published personal stories that expose*
13 *ableist attitudes, policies, and practices across a society that*
14 *pushes disabled people to the margins and shared her own*
15 *experiences navigating the world as a disabled person with a*
16 *progressive neuromuscular disease;*

1 *Whereas, In 2024, Alice was awarded a MacArthur
2 Foundation fellowship, commonly referred to as a "genius
3 grant", for her writing and work on behalf of the disabled
4 community;*

5 *Whereas, Alice edited two essay collections: Disability
6 Visibility, First-Person Stories from the Twenty-First Century,
7 published in 2020 and Disability Intimacy: Essays on Love,
8 Care, and Desire, published in 2024; and*

9 *Whereas, Alice is survived by her parents, Henry and
10 Bobby Wong, and her sisters, Emily Wong and Grace Wong:
11 Therefore,*

12 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the
13 General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

14 SECTION 1. That the Indiana State Senate expresses its
15 sympathy and deepest condolences to the family of Alice
16 Wong.
