MR. PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION honoring Senator Andrea
2 Hunley on her retirement.

4 *of the Indiana Senate from the 46th District since 2022,*
5 *becoming the Assistant Minority Leader in 2024;*

6 *Whereas, Senator Hunley earned her bachelor's in*
7 *secondary education and teaching from Indiana University*
8 *Bloomington in 2006, a master's degree in education from*
9 *Indiana University-Purdue University Indianapolis in 2010,*
10 *and a certificate from the Prospective Principal's Academy at*
11 *IU Bloomington in 2011;*

12 *Whereas, Before serving in elected office, Senator Hunley*
13 *was deeply involved in education as a public school teacher,*
14 *working as a K-8 public school principal with Indianapolis*
15 *Public Schools, an assistant principal with Metropolitan School*
16 *District of Washington Township, and as a high school English*
17 *teacher with the Metropolitan School District of Wayne*
18 *Township;*

 2 *that has generation impact on the health and wealth of*
 3 *individuals and communities, and she pursued that passion as*
 4 *a member of the Senate Committees on Utilities, Commerce and*

 6 *Labor, Tax and Fiscal Policy, Ethics, Elections, Family and*
 7 *Children Services, and Rules and Legislative Procedure;*

8 *Whereas, Senator Hunley is a member of the Zeta Phi Beta*
