SENATE RESOLUTION _____

MR. PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION urging the Legislative Council
2 to assign the topic of mobile driving credentials to the
3 appropriate study committee.

4 *Whereas, Digital driving credentials (or mobile driver's*
5 *licenses - mDLs) are offered to modernize identification (ID) by*
6 *replacing or supplementing physical cards with secure, digital,*
7 *and instantly verifiable versions on smartphones;*

8 *Whereas, mDLs are cryptographically signed, making them*
9 *much harder to forge than physical cards, supporting real-time*
10 *revocation if a device is stolen and biometric authentication to*
11 *prevent unauthorized access;*

12 *Whereas, Unlike a physical ID, which reveals personal*
13 *details at once, mDLs allow users to share only the necessary*
14 *information;*

15 *Whereas, mDLs allow for contactless, fast verification and*
16 *are Transportation Safety Administration approved;*

17 *Whereas, mDLs reduce the risks of identity theft and*
18 *provide a more secure method to conduct business;*



1 *Whereas, Offering mDLs provides significant cost savings*
2 *by eliminating the expenses associated with physical card*
3 *production, reducing labor-intensive administrative tasks, and*
4 *minimizing fraud; and*

5 *Whereas, Twenty states offer digital driving credentials:*

8 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the*
9 *General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

12 Council to assign the topic of mobile driving credentials to the
13 appropriate study committee.
