12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

14	Section 1. Section 13-1-104, MCA, is amended to read:		
15	"13-1-104. Times for holding general elections. (1) A general election must be held throughout the		
16	state on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November.		
17	(2)	In every even-numbered year, the following elections must be held on general election day:	
18	(a)	an election on any ballot issue submitted to electors pursuant to Article III, section 6, unless the	
19	legislature orders a special election, or Article XIV, section 8, of the Montana constitution;		
20	(b)	an election of federal officers, members of the legislature, state officers, multicounty district	
21	officers elected at a statewide election, district court judges, and county officers; and		
22	<u>(c)</u>	an election of officers for municipalities required by law to hold the election; and	
23	(c) (d)	any other election required by law to be held on general election day in an even-numbered	
24	year.		
25	(3)	In every odd-numbered year, the following elections must be held on the same day as the	
26	general election:		
27	(a)	an election of officers for municipalities required by law to hold the election; and	
28	(b)	any other Only an election required by law to be held on general election day in an odd-

3	Section 2. Section 13-1-107, MCA, is amended to read:		
4	"13-1-107. Times-Time for holding primary elections cost of municipal election. (1) On the first		
5	Tuesday after the first Monday in June preceding a general election held in an even-numbered year, a primary		
6	election must be held throughout the state.		
7	(2) On the Tuesday following the second Monday in September preceding a general election held		
8	in an odd-numbered year, a primary election, if required, must be held throughout the state.		
9	(3)(2) The cost of a municipal election must be paid by the municipality."		
10			
11	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Transition. (1) For a municipal officer whose term of office ends in		
12	January 2026, there must be an election in 2025 for a one-year term of office.		
13	(2) For a municipal officer whose term of office ends in January 2028 or January 2030, there must		
14	be a special election for a one-year term proceeding when their term of office is set to end. This special election		
15	must take place during the preceding even-numbered year general election.		
16			
17	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Saving clause. [This act] does not affect rights and duties that matured,		
18	penalties that were incurred, or proceedings that were begun before [the effective date of this act].		
19			
20	NEW SECTION. Section 5. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.		
21			
22	NEW SECTION. Section 6. Applicability. [This act] applies to all municipal elections scheduled on		
23	or after [the effective date of this act].
