13	court governor shall appoint members of the bar of this state, in good standing, as an examining board to
14	conduct and assist in conducting the examination of applicants for admission to the bar. The board may not
15	exceed seven members. The court governor may release, dismiss, or remove any member of the board and
16	appoint other members at any time.
17	(2) A majority of the board is a quorum and may conduct examinations.
18	(3) The board shall perform the duties and render assistance in the examinations of applicants as
19	prescribed by the court governor and is governed and controlled by the rules that the court governor may
20	prescribe."
