10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	Section 1. Section 44-1-1003, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"44-1-1003. Offenses on highways, rest areas, and state highway properties adjacent to the
14	highway, and capitol complex or involving motor vehicles. Patrol officers are considered police officers for
15	the purpose of making arrests for all offenses occurring on the highways, highway rest areas, state highway
16	properties adjacent to the highway, and the capitol complex as defined in 2-17-802 or involving the use of motor
17	vehicles or the registration thereof and for the purpose of serving warrants of arrest in connection with such
18	violations."

20	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
