A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING EDUCATION LAWS TO LIMIT THE ~~STATE PROMOTION OF AUTHORIZED~~ TEACHER ATTENDANCE AT MEETINGS OF TEACHER ORGANIZATIONS ~~TO PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT THAT IS SOLELY DEVOTED TO IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF INSTRUCTION AND ALIGNED TO STANDARDS OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC EDUCATION; PROHIBITING PUPIL-INSTRUCTION-RELATED DAYS FROM BEING USED FOR ATTENDING STATE MEETINGS OF TEACHER ORGANIZATIONS;~~ REMOVING THE MANDATE THAT TRUSTEES CLOSE SCHOOLS FOR THE ANNUAL MEETINGS OF TEACHER ORGANIZATIONS; AMENDING SECTIONS 20-1-304 AND 20-4-304, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

WHEREAS, pupil-instruction-related days are supported with state and local tax dollars; and
WHEREAS, recent professional development opportunities for teachers utilizing pupil-instruction-related days included political activity and unnecessarily divisive partisan content.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 20-1-304, MCA, is amended to read:

"20-1-304. Pupil-instruction-related day. (1) A pupil-instruction-related day is a day of:

(a) _____ teacher activities, including preparing for and conducting parent conferences and for end-of-

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1 term records days; or

2 (b) professional development that is solely devoted to improving the quality of instruction and

3 aligned to standards of the board of public education. The activities may include but are not limited to inservice

4 training, attending state meetings of teacher organizations, and conducting parent conferences. The activities

5 may not include attending state meetings of teacher organizations.

6 (2) A maximum of 7 pupil-instruction-related days may be conducted during a school year, with a

7 minimum of 3 of the days for instructional and professional development meetings or other appropriate

8 inservice training, if the days are planned in accordance with the policy adopted by the board of public

9 education. The days may not be included as a part of the required minimum aggregate hours of pupil

10 instruction."

12 **Section 2.** Section 20-4-304, MCA, is amended to read:

13 **"20-4-304. Attendance at instructional and professional development meetings.** The trustees of

14 a school district shall close the schools of the district for the annual instructional and professional development

15 meetings of teachers' organizations. The trustees of a school district may close the schools of the district for the

16 annual instructional and professional development meetings of teachers' organizations meeting the

17 requirements of 20-1-304. A teacher may attend instructional and professional development meetings without

18 loss of salary or attend other appropriate inservice training that may be prescribed by the trustees without loss

19 of salary. If a teacher does not attend, the teacher may not be paid."

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21 NEW SECTION. **Section 3. Effective date.** [This act] is effective July 1, 2025.

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
