14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

17 "20-7-330. **Creation of state plan committee -- meetings -- report.** (1) (a) The commissioner of
18 higher education and the superintendent of public instruction shall form a state plan committee as necessary to
19 update the state plan for career and technical education as required by 20 U.S.C. 2301.

20 (b) The superintendent of public instruction and the commissioner of higher education shall each
21 appoint three people from their respective advisory boards to serve on a committee to review and update the 5-
22 year state plan for career and technical education as required by 20 U.S.C. 2323. Two members appointed
23 from each advisory board must be educators, and the remaining member appointed from each advisory board
24 must be a representative of a business or community interest to serve on the state plan committee as follows:

25 (I) two educators; and

26 (iii) one representative of a business or community interest

27 (c) The superintendent of public instruction shall appoint three people to serve on the state plan
28 committee as follows:

1 (3) If the state plan committee submits a new or revised 5-year 4-year state plan in accordance
2 with subsection (2)(d)(2)(b)(iv), the plan must be written to coordinate with or to be included in the federal
3 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act combined state plan as provided in 53-2-1205.

4 (3)(4) The board of regents shall report the results of the meetings required in subsection (2) to the
5 legislature in accordance with the provisions of 5-11-210."

7 **NEW SECTION. Section 2. Directions to code commissioner.** Whenever a reference to "5-year
8 state plan for career and technical education reports" appears in Title 5 or Title 20 and in all law enacted by the
9 69th legislature, the code commissioner is directed to change it to a reference to "4-year state plan for career
10 and technical education reports".
