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5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A STUDY OF DEPARTMENT SUSPENSION OR  
6 CLOSURE OF NEW GROUND WATER APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FOX HILLS-HELL CREEK AQUIFER;  
7 PROVIDING FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF GROUND WATER AVAILABILITY; PROVIDING REPORTING  
8 REQUIREMENTS; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE AND A  
9 TERMINATION DATE."

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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

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13        NEW SECTION. Section 1. Fox Hills-Hell Creek aquifer -- ~~temporary suspension of action on~~  
14 ~~permits~~ -- groundwater study. (1) ~~In order to balance the need for continued development of Montana's water~~  
15 ~~and for protection of existing water rights in the Fox Hills-Hell Creek aquifer, the department may suspend~~  
16 ~~action on a class of applications or may close an aquifer source and refuse to accept a class of applications, or~~  
17 ~~both, for a permit to appropriate ground water from that source pursuant to this part.~~

18 (2) Pursuant to subsection (1), the department may suspend or close permit applications to  
19 appropriate ground water from the Fox Hills Hell Creek aquifer within department administrative boundaries  
20 39E, 39FJ, 39G, 39H, 40D, 40E, 40P, 40Q, 40R, 40S, 42A, 42C, 42J, 42K, 42KJ, 42L, and 42M if the proposed  
21 appropriation is 3,000 gallons a minute or more.

22       (3) The bureau of mines and geology shall complete a feasibility study on ground water availability  
23       from the Fox Hills-Hell Creek aquifer in the department administrative boundaries listed in subsection (2) 39E,  
24       39FJ, 39G, 39H, 40D, 40E, 40P, 40Q, 40R, 40S, 42A, 42C, 42J, 42K, 42KJ, 42L, and 42M. The study may  
25       include:

26 (a) the compilation and update of new geologic and hydrogeologic data;

27 (b) a limited field collection of water levels and pressure for wells with historical data;

1                   (c) a preliminary water budget for the Fox Hills-Hell Creek aquifer; and

2                   (d) a preliminary model to evaluate the effects of pumping on water levels and pressure.

3                   (2) The bureau shall report the progress and final results of its feasibility study to the water policy

4 interim committee established in 5-5-231, in accordance with 5-11-210. The committee shall consider the

5 results of the study and make recommendations to the legislature for department suspension or closure of new

6 ground water appropriations from the Fox Hills-Hell Creek aquifer.

8                   **NEW SECTION. Section 2. Transfer.** By June 30, 2025, the state treasurer shall transfer ~~\$5,000~~

9 ~~\$50,000 from the general fund~~ to the ground water assessment account in 85-2-905.

11                   **NEW SECTION. Section 3. Appropriation.** There is appropriated ~~\$5,000~~ ~~\$50,000~~ from the general

12 fund to the bureau of mines and geology for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for a feasibility study

13 pursuant to ~~subsection (3) of~~ [section 1(1)].

15                   **NEW SECTION. Section 4. Codification instruction.** [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an

16 integral part of Title 85, chapter 2, part 3, and the provisions of Title 85, chapter 2, part 3, apply to [section 1].

18                   **NEW SECTION. Section 5. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on passage and approval.

20                   **NEW SECTION. Section 6. Termination.** [This act] terminates June 30, 2027.
