18	must have a director of fire service or a fire chief, who shall manage and control the department in the manner
19	prescribed by the ordinances of the municipality.

22	"7-33-2110. Volunteer fire districts or companies fire departments pension not affected by
23	city-county consolidation. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the adoption of a city-county
24	consolidated local government has no effect on the existence of a volunteer fire department, a volunteer fire
25	company, or a fire district created and legally in existence pursuant to the provisions of this part unless
26	otherwise specifically provided by charter.
27	(2)—A right or benefit of any member of a volunteer fire district, company, or department created
28	pursuant to the provisions of this part in a retirement or pension plan or payments provided under Title 19,

5	"7-33-2316. Volunteer fire districts or companies fire departments pension not affected by
6	city-county consolidation. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the adoption of a city-county
7	consolidated local government has no effect on the existence of a volunteer fire department, a volunteer fire
8	company, or a fire district created and legally in existence pursuant to the provisions of this part unless
9	otherwise specifically provided by charter.
10	(2)—A right or benefit of any member of a volunteer fire district, company, or department created
11	pursuant to the provisions of this part in a retirement or pension plan or payments provided under Title 19,
12	chapter 17, may not be abrogated by the adoption of a city-county consolidated local government unless
13	otherwise specifically provided by charter."
