8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Prohibiti	ng weather modification. (1) Except as prescribed in 85-3-101
11	through 85-3-424, a person may not intentionally inject, release, or disperse chemicals, chemical compounds,	
12	substances, or apparatuses within the borders of Montana expressly for:	
13	(a) engaging in weather modification	on and control;
14	(b) affecting temperature; or	
15	(c) affecting the intensity of the sur	light.
16	(2) As used in this section:	
17	(a) "chemical compounds" means	any combination of any number of chemicals;
18	(b) "chemicals" means industrial su	ubstances, whether simple, compound, or obtained through the
19	process of the science and art of chemistry, whether of organic or inorganic origin; and	
20	(c) "weather modification and cont	ol" means changing or controlling or attempting to change or
21	control, by artificial methods, the natural development of atmospheric cloud forms or precipitation forms that	
22	occur in the troposphere.

24	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codifica	tion instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
25	integral part of Title 75, chapter 2, and the provisions of Title 75, chapter 2, apply to [section 1].
