

AN ACT APPROPRIATING MONEY TO PROVIDE STATEWIDE ACCESS TO A K-12 DIGITAL TOOLKIT; PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND A TERMINATION DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

**Section 1. Appropriation.** (1) The following money is appropriated from the general fund to provide statewide access to a K-12 digital toolkit that provides state standards-aligned, multimodal instructional materials across all content areas, including access to career and technical educational materials and local Montana industry partners to support workforce development:

- (a) for fiscal year 2026:
- (i) \$1.1 million to the office of public instruction; and
- (ii) \$750,000 to the department of labor and industry; and
- (b) for fiscal year 2027:
- (i) \$1.1 million to the office of public instruction; and
- (ii) \$750,000 to the department of labor and industry.
- (2) The legislature intends that the appropriations in this section be considered part of the ongoing base for the next legislative session.
  - **Section 2. Effective date.** [This act] is effective July 1, 2025.
  - Section 3. Termination. [This act] terminates June 30, 2029.
