Bill Summary: AB 2730 requires adjacent counties, upon request, to enter into agreements to permit the use of emergency management and transportation services in the event of an emergency that requires the evacuation and relocation of their access and functional needs population.

The following information is revised to reflect amendments adopted by the committee on August 20, 2020

Fiscal Impact: Negligible state costs.

Author Amendments:

- Require the service agreements between adjacent counties to be available 24 hours per day, seven days per week.
- Revise the definition of "adjacent county" to mean a county with the same or a
 contiguous mutual aid region(s) as specified is a subdivision of the state emergency
 services organization, established to facilitate the coordination of mutual aid and
 other emergency operations within an area of the state consisting of two or more
 county operational areas.

Committee Amendments:

- Authorize instead of requires adjacent counties to enter into agreements.
- Make other conforming changes.
