## **Fiscal Impact:**

Unknown cost pressure, likely in the millions of dollars (special fund), due to an
expansion of the number of unserved households/areas that would be eligible for
funding from the CASF program.

**Committee Amendments:** Committee amendments would ensure that the bill could be implemented without increasing the surcharge on customers by making the eligibility expansion contingent upon sufficiency of existing resources.
