The following information is revised to reflect amendments adopted by the committee on August 26, 2021

## **Fiscal Impact:**

- <u>Courts</u>: Unknown, potentially-significant workload cost pressures to the courts to adjudicate alleged violations of this measure. While the superior courts are not funded on a workload basis, an increase in workload could result in delayed court services and would put pressure on the General Fund to increase the amount appropriated to backfill for trial court operations. For illustrative purposes, the Budget Act of 2021 allocates \$118.3 million from the General Fund for insufficient revenue for trial court operations. (General Fund\*)
- <u>Department of Justice (DOJ)</u>: Unknown workload cost pressures to enforce the provisions of this measure. (Special fund\*\*)

Committee Amendments: Exclude vehicle service contracts from the bill.
