SB 125 (Committee on Budget and Fiscal Review)

As Amended June 26, 2022

Majority vote. Budget Bill Appropriations Take Effect Immediately

SUMMARY

This bill creates a tax on lithium extraction on a per metric ton basis and makes other related statutory changes to implement the Lithium Valley proposals adopted in the budget.

Major Provisions

- 1) Beginning January 1, 2023, creates a lithium extraction excise tax on a per ton basis, specifically:
 - a) \$400 per metric ton extracted under 20,000 metric tons or less
 - b) \$600 per metric ton extracted between 20,000 and 30,000 metric tons
 - c) \$800 per metric ton extracted over 30,000 metric tons
- 2) Specifies that the tax is in lieu of all county, municipal, or district taxes on lithium extraction or lithium storage, except as provided.
- 3) Appropriates 80% of the tax collections to the county where the lithium was extracted and 20% to the Salton Sea Restoration Fund for restoration and community projects at or around the Salton Sea.
- 4) Requires the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration, on or before December 31, 2023, to prepare a study of replacing a volume-based tax on the extraction of lithium with an equivalent tax based on gross receipts.
- 5) Clarifies that "mining operation" includes the extraction of minerals from geothermal brine, or any other brine, including, but not limited to, a mining operation colocated or co-operated with geothermal resource facilities.
