****** ANALYSIS ADDENDUM - SUSPENSE FILE ********

The following information is revised to reflect amendments adopted by the committee on May 19, 2022

Fiscal Impact: This bill, per the revenue loss estimates of the Franchise Tax Board, would result in General Fund cost pressures of \$44 million in 2022-23, \$90 million in 2023-24, and \$100 million in 2024-25. FTB's costs to implement the bill have yet to be determined.

Committee Amendments: Make the bill contingent upon an appropriation by the Legislature.
