

California) program for the purpose of providing programs and services to older adults, adults with disabilities, family caregivers and residents in long-term care facilities throughout the state. The CDA contracts with 33 Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs) that provide services directly or through contracts with community providers. Services provided include home adaptation funding, provision of assistive devices, support groups, nutrition programs, including congregate nutrition programs and home-delivered meal programs, disease prevention and health promotion programs, family caregiver support programs, including training and education, and supportive services programs.

- 5) **Prior Legislation.** AB 2719 (Irwin), Chapter 202, Statutes of 2018, added sexual orientation, gender identity, and gender expression to the definition of communities to be considered for programs and services administered through CDA.

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
