The following information is revised to reflect amendments adopted by the committee on May 20, 2021

## **Fiscal Impact:**

- While the provisions of the bill would be contingent upon an appropriation, it could lead to Proposition 98 General Fund cost pressure in the millions to low tens of millions of dollars for the state fund them.
- The CDE estimates General Fund costs of approximately \$918,000 over a fouryear period for various administrative activities necessary to comply with the bill's requirements.

**Committee Amendments:** Remove the bill's appropriations and make its provisions contingent upon an appropriation.
