**SUBJECT:** Budget Acts of 2022 and 2023

**DIGEST:** This bill amends the 2023 and 2022 budget acts to reflect changes necessary to update the 2023 budget agreement assuming the prior adoption and chaptering of SB 104, which amends the budget act to finalize budget details and address technical issues.

*Assembly Amendments* delete the Senate version of the bill and instead add the current language.

**ANALYSIS:** This bill makes the following changes:

- 1) Removes \$3 million provided to the Department of Industrial Relations to resume the operations of the Industrial Welfare Commission;
- 2) Includes and corrects funding authority for federal American Rescue Plan Act funding provided for afterschool and summer programs;
- 3) Removes an unneeded reappropriation of a 2021 legislative priority administered by the Natural Resources Agency;
- 4) Provides the Energy Commission with spending authority for approximately \$102.8 million in additional federal grant funds;

- 5) Reappropriates federal funds budgeted for the Energy Commission in the 2018 budget Act; and
- 6) Corrects provisional language related to the reappropriation of facilities development funding at the Department of Health Care Access and Information.
