Bill Summary: SB 478 would make it an unlawful business practice to advertise, display, or offer a price for a good or service that does not include all mandatory fees or charges other than taxes imposed by a government.

Fiscal Impact: Unknown court workload cost pressures in order to adjudicate civil violations of this bill's provisions (Trial Court Trust Fund, General Fund).

Author Amendments: Provide that specified fees and charges relating to vehicle sales do not violate the provisions of this bill.

Committee Amendments: Provide that providing broadband internet access in compliance with Federal regulations, as specified, shall be deemed compliant with the provisions of this bill.
