Bill Summary: This bill authorizes occupational therapists (OTs) and physical therapists (PTs) to be eligible for a preliminary administrative services credential.

****** ANALYSIS ADDENDUM - SUSPENSE FILE ********

The following information is revised to reflect amendments adopted by the committee on August 29, 2025

Fiscal Impact: The CTC estimates General Fund costs of \$127,000 each year for 1.0 position to create resources, provide technical assistance to local educational agencies (LEAs) and the public, and process additional applications.

Author Amendments: Modify the proposed qualifications for occupational and physical therapists to meet the minimum requirements for a preliminary administrative services credential, as specified, including an increase to the minimum experience requirement; authorize a waiver of up to two years of the minimum experience requirement; and specify that a preliminary administrative services credential shall not authorize the supervision or evaluation of teachers except under specified circumstances.
