****** ANALYSIS ADDENDUM - SUSPENSE FILE *******

The following information is revised to reflect amendments adopted by the committee on August 29, 2025

Fiscal Impact: Unknown ongoing costs for CDSS for state administration and for tribal child welfare agencies to fund legal representation (General Fund and federal funds).

Author Amendments: Revise provisions related to funding support for the cost of independent legal representation on behalf of the child, and include a requirement for CDSS to develop a cost allocation plan, as specified.
