- 2) **Government Transparency.** Existing law requires each state agency to disclose certain information on its internet website, including information related to each agency's duties. Existing law also requires each state agency to prepare and maintain financial and accounting data for inclusion in the Governor's Budget, Budget Act, and related documents. This bill requires each state agency that imposes a monetary charge to annually report, beginning January 1, 2028, the revenue generated from such charges on the agency's website. However, this bill does not specify the point in time for which revenue must be reported. Additionally, the definition of "state agency" referenced by this bill does not include the California State University.
