SUBJECT: November 3, 2026, statewide general election: ballot measures

DIGEST: This bill prescribes the ballot placement and numbering for five ballot measures for the November 3, 2026, statewide general election.

ANALYSIS: This bill prescribes the ballot placement and numbering for five ballot measures for the November 3, 2026, statewide general election. Specifically, this bill:

- 1) Prescribes the following placement and number for five ballot measures:
 - a) Place first on the ballot as Proposition 1 - The Veterans and Affordable Housing Bond Act of 2026 (Sections 2 and 3 of SB 417 (Limón), Chapter 16, Statutes of 2026).
 - b) Place second on the ballot as Proposition 2 - The Save for California's Future Act (ACA 20 (Gabriel), Chapter 130, Resolution Chapter 130, Statutes of 2026).

- c) Place third on the ballot as Proposition 3 - The California Children's Education and Health Care Protection Act of 2026 (Secretary of State Initiative #1993).
 - d) Place fourth on the ballot as Proposition 4 - The California Fair Elections Act of 2026 (Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4.1 of SB 42 (Umbert)), Chapter 245, Statutes of 2025).
 - e) Place fifth on the ballot as Proposition 5 - SCA 1 (Newman), Resolution Chapter 204, Statutes of 2024.
- 2) Provides that nothing in this bill affects the placement or numbering of any other measure qualified for the November 3, 2026, statewide general election ballot.
- 3) Contains an urgency clause.
